Give Blood & Join the Marrow Donor Registry

People of Asian heritage are especially encouraged to give blood in honor of the late Kirby Wong, a Seattle man who required more than 500 units of blood while waiting for a heart transplant.

Currently people of color represent less than 1% of the blood that is donated. Patients requiring multiple transfusions need donated blood that is perfectly matched to their own.

More people of color are needed to join the National Marrow Donor Registry. Patients' lives depend on finding a compatible donor, and those matches are found most often between people of the same ethnic group.
